Excellence in Academics

I wish to begin with our excellent results in CBSE Board Exams.

Firstly, We have had excellent results in Class XII and Class X in the session 2022-2023. **MANANSINGLA** of Class X secured 98.2% in his boards which is a matter of great pride not only for our School but also for the city of Samana.He was followed by**SARVOTAM SINGH**who got 96.8% and**KOMALDEEP KAUR**who got 95.8% in Class X. We are really proud to share that 11 students of Class X secured 90% and above and 11 Students of Class XII secured 90% and above. We had 100% board result for Class X and 97% for Class XII.

In Class XII KOMALPREET KAUR from Humanities stream secured 93.4% followed by KHUSHMEENPREET KAUR with 88% and PRABHMOHAN SINGH with 87.8%.RATINDERDEEP SINGH from Non-Medical Stream secured 93.2% followed by MANAVGARG with 91.6% whereas RHYTHMPREETKAUR and ARUSHISINGLA secured 90% each. From Medical stream BHUMIKA and DIVYA Secured 90.2% each.DEPINDERJOTKAUR and SARWAN SINGH from Commerce stream secured 90.4% each. They were followed by HASMUKH PATHAK and PARTEEK DHAWAN who secured 90% each.

Result of Olympiads

Every year number of students participate in Olympiads. This year also students have done well in various Olympiads. In International Mathematics Olympiad 4 students won gold Medals. 6 students have won Gold Medals in National Science Olympiad. 4 Students have won Gold Medals in International English Olympiad. One student has won Gold Medal in National Commerce Olympiad. Five students qualified for 2nd level Olympiad two each in Maths and Science and one in English.

There was Quest Olympiad also in which 11 students won gold medals in colouring by Aptitude, Colouring by Theme, Colouring by Imagination. Students won in Handwriting and even in Mathematics, English, Science and G.K. Olympiad. It is matter of great pride for us to share the news that one of our studentsfrom class 2nd A, **SANGRAM SINGH** is the All India Winner of G.K. Olympiad.

Co-Curricular Activities

School also plays a significant role by helping the children decide, what is good for them and what is bad for them. Special assemblies, counselling sessions, career counselling workshops all are a part of curriculum. Special assemblies on "Say no to Drugs", Safe Driving, Disaster Management were arranged by the students with the help of teachers to make other students aware, that what is going about in the world and how to safeguard ourselves.

Coming to sports arena, I would like to share the news of 6thHeroes Taekwondo International Championship that was held on 1st and 2nd July, at Bangkok, Thailand:**TANISHQ GARG** from class 10th won the silver medal in the same.

Roller Skating Federation of India & Jammu & Kashmir, Roller Skating Association organized National inline Hokey tournament that was held at Jammu. Ten States participated in this tournament and the gold Medal was won by **ATAMA SINGH** of XI Humanities Awho was a part of Punjab Team.

Again it is a matter of immense pride that 3 students won Gold medals in boxing at National Level They are MANVIR SINGH, VISHAL SINGH and UDEYVEER SINGH.

MANVIR SINGH of XIreceived the title of the best boxer of Punjab.

It is a matter of immense joy for all of us as at State Level, We have won a Gold Medal, a Silver medal and a Bronze Medal in Karate. In boxing also we have won two Gold Medals. One of our student has won Bronze Medal in High Jump at State Level.

ANSHINDER SINGH from class 3rd won Gold Medal ,**SAMARDEEP KUMAR** from class XII and **ANSHDEEP SINGH** from class 10th won Silver Medals and **AMRITPREET KAUR** from class XII won BronzeMedalat State Level in Karate.
